System Assets/CIP	Green	9 to 22 months	
Comments: Green - Michigan Avenue water main lining project scheduled for Spring 2022. Green - Water main replacement on Marlpool, Forestbrooke currently in final design stages, targeting March 2022 bidding. Green - Eastbelt (Maple Avenue) water main replacement scheduled to start September 2022.			
General Maintenance	Yellow	Ongoing	
Comments: Yellow - Dead-end flushing to recommence January 2021. Yellow - Council approved a valve turning and maintenance program (December 6). Two year project with additional valve repair anticipated for FY23 and FY24. Yellow - Staff is researching and presenting alternatives for an AMI meter system.			
Mapping/GIS	Yellow	6 to 18 months	
Comments: Green - General system data populated and accessible. Yellow - Valve status is incomplete, valve contract includes populating date into ESRI system. Green - GIS mapping and data collection deployed for hydrant flushing, now a part of regular operations. Yellow - Staff considering options for incorporating as-built information into GIS system.

Studies and Modeling	Yellow	4 to 12 months	
Comments: Green - Council approved new Water Reliability Study and hydraulic modeling (December 6) for FY22. Last model completed FY16/17. Green - Risk and Resiliency Assessment in progress. Yellow - Criticality assessment needed to determine chance of failure for older lines.			
Other Technology	Yellow	9 to 12 months	
Comments: Yellow - Staff identifying alternatives for work order system. Yellow - Targeting new customer portal for utility billing as part of AMI water meter project; other alternatives to improve utility user communications and alerts will need to be considered if AMI change out is not approved.			
Water Quality	Yellow	Ongoing	
Comments: Green - Currently in compliance with state testing standards for all plant and distribution system requirements including lead and bacteria. Green - Advanced lead and bacteria testing now available for private residents through partnership with WCHD. Yellow - Month over month resident discoloration complaints trending downward but still higher than normal. Eighteen unique complaints received to-date in December.
