The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality proposes to modify a discharge permit issued to: the City of Saline for the Saline Water Treatment Plant located at 401 Breconshire Drive, Saline, Michigan 48176. The applicant provides centralized iron removal and softening of municipal water for the City of Saline. The applicant discharges filter backwash and reverse osmosis concentrate via storm sewers to the Saline River, in the SW1/4, SW1/4, Section 36, Town 3S, Range 5E, Washtenaw County.

The draft permit includes the following modifications to the previously issued permit: reduction in the maximum flow rate from 0.86 million gallons per day (MGD) to 0.65 MGD based on two years of operational data, a corresponding reduction in loads for Total Dissolved Solids; inclusion of monitoring for Total Selenium; and an increase in the Chronic Toxicity limit from 1.6 TU_c to 2.1 TU_c because of the reduced authorized flow.
